FRINGE JEANS


Whether the hem of the waist is frayed or the bottom of the pants is full of fringe, this style can be dressed up or down!

WAISTED EXTREME FLARE JEANS



IMTA absolutely affected me in a positive way: my level of confidence increased, I learned to accept the rejection I needed to stay in the industry, how to ace auditions, how to be professional during jobs as well as when talking to designers and directors.

My whole career has basically sprung to life thanks to my experience at IMTA. I know IMTA will absolutely change the lives of future contestants. My advice is just be yourself, be confident and try your best. Participating in IMTA will allow you to meet more agencies and people in the industry than you could in a year of living in LA or NYC. IMTA is the opportunity of a lifetime.

At 13 years old I became very ill and eating, which is something people should be able to enjoy, became something I did just to survive. Every time I ate I was in pain and I felt nauseous. As time went on my symptoms only became worse and led to the need of feeding-tube's for most and eventually all nutrition.

At 14, after multiple doctor appointments, ER visits and hospital stays, I was given a diagnosed of Gastroparesis. The cause of the paralysis of my stomach is still of unknown etiology but I am hoping for answers someday soon.

Having a feeding-tube as a 13 year old girl was hard and even harder because at that time it was in my nose. Everyone noticed , people stared and even whispered to one another about the thing in my nose. At 15, I decided for myself, as well as others, that someone needed to put a stop to anyone feeling uncomfortable about going out in public with a medical device. I wanted to become a role model for others. After meeting my agency, A-list Models and Talent, I learned so much about myself and my rue passion for Modeling and Acting.

At 16, after nearly losing my life to sepsis the first time and upon surgery for a gj tube placement I decided that I wanted to use my Make a wish. My wish was to go to "IMTA" (International Models and Talent Association) L.A 2016 with the help of A-list models and talent, IMTA and Make a wish Eastern N.C it came true. Looking back at 18, I now can say I don't regret a single decision made.



IMTA truly was, and is, the experience of a lifetime. Going up on that stage gave me a taste of the industry and it allowed me to meet multiple agents. It was truly the best week of my life. If I could relive it and do it all over again I truly would. There wasn't a moment I wasn't Modeling, Acting or Singing at IMTA.

Since IMTA, I have been on "Good Morning America" while modeling for "Headbands of Hope", I have been featured in Le Reve Magazine, I was in Art in bloom a fashion show with live plants as outfits and most recently I walked in Art Hearts "New York Fashion Week" for Snooty Booty designs in which history was made since I was the first Tube-fed model to walk the runway

Now I am a Senior Ambassador for the upcoming program "Power of The Possible", which is a program to help sick kids and adults to follow their dreams through the performing arts.

I won overall best on the runway, people's choice award as Best Intermediate Model and Best Commercial Model at Le Reve Magazine 2017 Elite Super Model.

I have been in many print ads and recently was in the Burlington Times "she expo" ad for Saks Off 5th Avenue with photos by Lamont Johnson. I have also been a double and an extra in a movie that is in post-production.
